

TAX SEASON TIPS OF THE DAY

IRS is NOT going to call or Email you! Social Security 1099 forms and other tax forms are in the mail. Pick up your mail ASAP. Remember, *these forms have your social security number on them*!

TAX REFUNDS OR PAYMENTS

Best Choice: Get your refund or pay your tax via direct deposit/electronic transfer. *2nd Choice*: If you must use the USPS mail, mail your letter at the post office, pay for a receipt from IRS and tracking.

See Photos of Your Mail Before It Arrives, **and its Free!** The post office will send you an email with photos of your mail whenever you have mail and/or packages coming. This way you will know when it's especially important to pick up your mail as soon as it arrives.

EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION

A resident had a heart attack while driving in Lincoln Hills. If you see paramedics, it is important to call the Village Coordinator so they can notify the emergency contacts. In this case the hospital had a hard time finding next of kin. This is also a reminder to keep your emergency contact information up to date in your home AND <u>on your phone</u>.
