Traffic Violation SCAM ALERT!

The Lincoln Police Department is aware of a recent fraudulent traffic violation notice being sent to local citizens. While some notices appear convincing, the following information is important to consider when determining whether it is a scam.

Legitimate toll or parking violations will always be mailed to a specific address, **NEVER** sent via text message or email

✔ **DO NOT** scan QR Codes

✔ **Block** the phone number

FINAL NOTICE — COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTION

You must take one of the following actions without delay:

- Remit full payment of all outstanding tolls, fines, civil penalties, administrative fees, and court costs; OR
- Appear before the Court at the scheduled hearing to address this matter

⚠ FAILURE TO PAY OR APPEAR WILL RESULT IN:

- Entry of a final default judgment against you
- Imposition of maximum statutory penalties and court costs
- Referral of the debt to a licensed collection agency
- Suspension of your California driver's license and vehicle registration
- Issuance of a Court Order to Show Cause and potential contempt proceedings
- Possible adverse impact to your credit profile associated with your Social Security Number
- Additional enforcement actions as permitted under California law
