

Neighborhood Watch is sharing this information as a reminder of the upcoming **Free Medication Take-Back event**, a valuable opportunity for our community.

This event, hosted at the <u>Lincoln Police Department</u>, (770 7th Street, near the corner of 7th Street and H Street) on <u>October 26th</u>, <u>2024</u>, <u>between 10am -2 pm</u>, allows citizens to drive up and drop off any unwanted/expired medications, from over-the-counter drugs to prescribed medications. **The process is fast, easy, and anonymous, providing a safe and responsible way to dispose of medications**.
