Wildfire Community Assessment

- Is there a wildfire threat?
 - Vegetation
 - Topography, slope
- What is the overall design?
 - Open spaces
 - Mature vegetation
 - Age of the community
 - Density of community
 - Evacuation concerns (1 way in / 1 way out)
 - Water supply capabilities, fire response times

Wildfire Property Assessment

- Where is your property located?
 - Near wildfire threat
 - On a slope
 - Home spacing
- What is your landscape?
 - Defensible space
 - Mature vegetation
- What is your homes construction?
 - Newer construction, sprinklers
 - Open or closed eaves
 - Materials





Wildfire Plan Assessment

- Do you have a wildfire plan?
- What are your priorities?
- What will you take with you?
- What will you do before you leave!

Wildfire Community Preparation

- Mitigate hazards
 - Give the most attention to your greatest threat areas
 - Ensure adequate defensible space 150'
 - · Create an evacuation plan
- Take a community approach
 - Become a FIREWISE community
 - True fire prevention can not be done alone
 - Evacuation drills





Wildfire Property Preparation

Defensible Space 0-5' Zone 0

- Fire resistive building materials
- Ember resistive vents
- Box and conceal eves to remove void spaces

Defensible space 30' around home Zone 1

- · Clean up debris and anything that can be a fuel to your home
- Trees 10' of clearance
- Store combustibles 30' away from home

Defensible space 100' around home Zone 2

- · Clear any vegetation to a low level threat
- Prepare according to the threat around our home
- Thinning of vegetation

Wildfire Plan Preparation

- Remember Life over Property
- Utilize real time information Watch Duty App, Social Media
- Have important documents and items in a READY STATE to take with you
- Have an emergency kit ready



- Shut all windows and doors and shut off utilities GAS/ Electricity/ Water only if you have time
- Know your evacuation route, notify others where you are leaving



LFD Wildfire Assessment

- Where is our biggest wildfire threats?
- What is the state of our water supply?
- What is our wildfire response plan?
- What training are we conducting with our personnel and the community?

- We have developed pre-planning for areas of greatest concern
- We have assessed our water supply capabilities and our actively inspecting our fire hydrants
- We are working on mutual aid responses with our surrounding agencies
- We will be conducting annual wildfire training and offering training to the community
