

3 STEPS TO PREVENT ABUSE



Keep medication out of sight and in a safe and secure place.



Keep track of medication and take only as directed.



Drop off unused medication at local Take Back locations.

ACCEPTABLE

- Prescription
- Non-prescription (over the counter)
- Controlled substances
- Veterinary medications

UNACCEPTABLE

- No sharps or lancets
- No medical waste

Leave pills and liquids in their original containers.
