### **→ SECURE YOUR HOME, PERSONAL, & FINANCIAL WELFARE**

Keep landscaping trimmed away from you home to eliminate hiding places for unwanted persons or critters.

Lock and secure your vehicle, in or out of your garage—never leave items of value in your vehicle.

Keep your garage door shut when not in use—not left partially open to critters or fully open to possible theft.

Security Screens, Motion lights, alarm systems, and cameras *could* be helpful to you and police department.

Keep lights, radio, and/or TV on timers or use “smart plugs” to control from anywhere—always look occupied!

Phone calls or emails asking for money or gift cards are probable scams---don’t lose your money to fraud.

When out and about—check your surroundings, park in well-lit area, hide personal items—lock your vehicle.
